RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current NEHC rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
- 2. Management reserves the right to vary or change show officials or judges. To decline any entry and cancel, divide or combine classes if there are less than four entries.
- 3. Any horse entered and not exhibited shall forfeit fees, unless the committee is presented with a veterinary certificate or in equitation only, a physician's certificate in the case of the rider. There will be a scratch charge of \$25.00 per entry.
- 4. The committee reserves the right not to delay classes due to conflicts and not allow substitutions of classes or horses.
- 5. No exhibitor or person shall approach a judge in any manner as to a decision or other matters unless they first obtain permission from the Show Steward. Any exhibitor or person disregarding this rule may be asked to cancel all entries and forfeit entry fees. Judges' decisions are final.
- 6. Please remember to bring your pony and junior hunter measurement cards and amateur certification. Numbers will not be issued without them.
- 7. ENTRIES may be received until 5:00pm the Friday before the show. After 5:00pm entries will be considered Post Entries. Post entries will be accepted the day of the show, however there will be a onetime post entry fee of \$25.00.
- 8. Schooling will be permitted in authorized areas only. Anyone found violating these rules shall forfeit all entry fees and not be allowed to show.
- 9. Courses will be posted at the in gate.
- 10. A prize and six ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise specified.
- 11. All horses entered in championship classes must show in one other class in the same division.
- 12. Only service dogs will be allowed on the property and must be leashed at all times.
- 13. A championship and reserve shall be awarded to the horses that have acquired the most points performing in a division; Short Stirrup Hunter, Long Stirrup Hunter, Pre-Child/Adult Equitation, Pre-Child/Adult Hunter, Children's Equitation, Child/Adult Special Hunter, Adult Hunter & Children's Hunter Horse. Points: 10-6-4-2-1-1/2.
- 14. All riders, while on the show grounds must wear protective headgear passing ASTM testing standards. Harnesses must be secured and fit to the rider. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until his headgear is properly in place.
- 15. Checks returned for any reason will be subject to a \$50.00 fine.
- 16. Entries not paid the day of the show will be subject to a \$100.00 fine.
- 17. Open check signed and written to "Maplewood" must be left with Entry Blank in order to pick up exhibitor number.

A contestant must accumulate 10 points to qualify for finals.

All Riders must present a valid membership number before entering this class. Open to junior members who have not reached their 18th birthday. Course requires 8 Fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual test of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USAE test 1-19). Any qualifying Rider is not eligible to enter at future shows. 10 points are needed to qualify for Finals. To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course.

14. MHC Junior Medal; 3' 17. MHC Junior Medal; 3'

MHJ Junior Hunt Seat Medal

Open to junior members who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current year. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'3" in height. One or more tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion.(USEF Tests 1-19). Ten points or the finals. To fill a class at least 2 exhibitors must complete the course.

15. MHJ Junior Medal; 3'3"

NEHC Junior Hunt Seat Medal

All Riders must present a valid membership number before entering this class. Open to Riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. Any qualifying Rider is not eligible to enter at future shows violation will forfeit eligibility for finals for that year. Course requires 8 Fences not to exceed 3'3". One or more individual test of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USAE test 1-19). To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course.

16. NEHC Junior Medal; 3'3"

Children's Hunter Horse - Rated NEHC "C"

Open to Junior Riders. Junior riders 15 to 17 years of age, must be eligible for Intermediate Equitation over Fences as of December 1st of the current show year. Fences 3" - spreads not to exceed fence height. Same Horse/Pony-Rider combination may not show in any other rated division except Equitation at the show. Horses may be shown by another Rider in any other division. To show at a walk, trot and canter.

Adult Amateur Hunter - Rated NEHC "C"

To be ridden by amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. Horses may be shown by a different rider in any other division or class at the same competition. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, size of rider to mount, and suitability as an Adult Amateur Hunter. Horses and ponies may be jogged for soundness at Judge's discretion. Height of fences 3', spreads not to exceed height of fence. Ponies may be ridden by adults, suitability to count. Division may be divided if sufficient entries. Divisions may be divided if 6 entries in each section.

MHC Adult Medal

All Riders must present a valid membership number before entering this class. Open to adult members of MHC. Course requires 8 Fences 2'6" to 2'9" with at least one change of direction. Once qualified, rider is no longer eligible for this class. One or more individual tests of the top 4 competitors may be requested at the judge's discretion (USAE tests 1-17). To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course.

29. MHC Adult Medal; 2'6"-2'9"

32. MHC Adult Medal; 2'6"-2'9"

MHJ Adult Medal

Open to Amateur Adult riders. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 Fences 2'9" to 3' including a combination with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. To fill, at least 2 competitors must complete the course.

30. MHJ Adult Medal; 2'9"-3'

NEHC Amateur Adult Medal

All Riders must present a valid membership number before entering this class. Open to adult members of NEHC. Course requires 8 Fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top 4 competitors may be requested at the judge's discretion (USAF tests 1-19). To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course.

31. NEHC Adult Medal; 3'

Children's / Adult Special Hunter

Open to Amateur Adult and Junior Riders. No Professionals. Open to Horses and Ponies that have not jumped 3' or over in the previous year, OR Riders who have not shown at 3' or over in the previous year. Fences not to exceed 2'6". No in and outs.

MHJ Adult Mini Medal

Open to Amateur Adult riders. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 Fences 2'9" to 3' including a combination with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. To fill, at least 2 competitors must complete the course. Riders may not cross enter into the MHJ Adult Medal. To qualify: 10 points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class.

37. MHJ Adult Mini Medal; 2'6"

Hunter Pleasure - Rated NEHC "C"

Open to all Horses of the Hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitation to the status of the Rider. To show at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the Horses' mouth is required. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness. Rider must show in Class 39 to show in Class 40

39. Hunter Pleasure; Open to all horses of the hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to status of rider. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness.

40. Hunter Pleasure; Championship To be eligible, must have been entered, shown and judged in the above Open class. Specifications same as Open class.

NEHC Pleasure Class - Rated NEHC "C"

Open to all Horses and Ponies to be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Will be required to back. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality, in that order. Loose rein on command of judge only, but without loss of contact. Rider must show in Class 39 to show in Class 41

41. NEHC Pleasure Class

MHC Mini Medal

All Riders must present a valid membership number before entering this class. Open to Riders who have not reached their 15th birthday and who have not competed in classes in which the entry is required to jump higher than 3'. All contestants are to compete over a course not exceeding 8 Fences and not less than six fences, excluding combination fences, at a height not to exceed 2'6"for ponies and horses. One or more individual test may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF current tests 1-8.) After qualifying, contestant is no longer eligible for this class. Ten point are required to qualify for the finals. (10, 6, 4, 2 points). A Mini-Medal rider who competes in the Jr. Medal prior to the finals is no longer eligible for the Mini-Medal Final. To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course.

MHJ Mini Medal

Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 15th birthday as of December 1 st of the current show year [exception Maiden and Novice riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 st of the current show year.] To perform over at least six fences not to exceed 2'6'. At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for the points to count. To qualify: 10 points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class. Riders may cross enter into the Children's equitation Medal but can only compete in either the Mini-Medal or Children's Equitation Medal but not both at the finals.

46. MHJ Mini-Medal 2'6"

MHJ Children's Equitation Medal

Open to all horses and ponies. Open to riders who have not yet reached their 18th birthday. Riders may not cross enter into junior equitation. Fences 2' for small/medium ponies, 2'6' for large ponies/horses. At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for the points to count.

50. MHJ Children's Medal 2'6"

Children's Equitation - Rated NEHC "C"

Open to exhibitors who are eligible for Children's Hunter Division and who have not shown over a course where fences exceed 3'. Fences for small/medium ponies - 2', fences for large ponies and horses - 2'6".

Lead Line

Open to Riders 6 years of age and under. To show collectively at the walk and individually at the trot. To be judged with emphasis on equitation; also suitability and manners of mount to be considered. Leader on foot must be 18 years of age or older. Handlers/riders must be properly attired. Rider may only compete in this division.

Walk Trot 10 years and under- Rated NEHC "C"

Open to riders 10 years of age and under. No child may compete in any other class requiring entries to canter at any previous show. Rider must show in regular class in order to compete in the championship class.

Divisions are based on the Rider Ability only. In the interest of safety is NOT based on the horse's ability (i.e., Green or Novice Horse). Open riders 11 years of age and older who have not cantered in a show for the past 3 years. No person entered may compete in any other class requiring entries to canter during the current show year. Once a rider has cantered in a show they are no longer eligible of this division. Open to horses and ponies. To be shown at a walk and trot both ways of the ring and will be asked to reverse at the walk

- 62. Walk Trot Child/Adult; Equitation 11 & Over. Shall show at a walk and trot only both ways of the ring.

Short Stirrup Equitation - Rated NEHC "C"

Open to riders 12 years of age or under. Not to compete in any other Equitation class at any show and has not competed in a jumping class over 18" in height. Only 8 horses or ponies to canter at once.

- 67. Short Stirrup; Equitation Flat To be judged at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. May be asked to halt and back. No more than 8 riders to canter at one time
- 68. Short Stirrup; Equitation Fences 18" To be shown over a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 fences not exceeding 18" in height. Fences may be taken at a trot or canter at the option of the rider.

MHJ Short Stirrup Medal

Open to Riders 12 years of age and under. To show over a course of 4 to 8 fences at a height of 18". The fences shall be cross rails or verticals with no combinations. To fill a class and for points to count at least two riders must complete the course. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class.

69. Short Stirrup; Eq. Championship / MHJ Medal 18"

Short Stirrup Hunter - Rated NEHC "C"

Open to Riders 12 years of age and under. To show over a course of 4 to 8 fences at a height of 18". The fences shall be cross rails or verticals with no combinations. Under Saddle class will show at a walk, trot and canter. Rider may not show in any class requiring fences higher than 18". Only 8 horses or ponies to canter at once
